At 23 May 2011, representatives from research institutes and from INGEDE members came together to hold an INGEDE Method Workshop in Grenoble at CTP. After the project meeting of INGEDE project 132 the main focus was to discuss the experiences with the INGEDE Method 11p to prepare the modifications for the transformation into an “INGEDE Method 11” in the future. In the afternoon, the participants from PMV Darmstadt, PTS München, CTP Grenoble, UPM, STORA ENSO, SCA and the INGEDE office discussed the proposals for certain steps in the laboratory procedure.

The ongoing work on the INGEDE Method 11p will improve the tool of deinkability evaluation. The method has been developed to simulate the common operating conditions of relevant process steps in an industrial deinking plant under standard conditions in a laboratory scale.

The workshop comprised other INGEDE Methods as well. For example the text in the next version of INGEDE Method 5 will fit to the recent version of INGEDE Method 2. INGEDE Method 1 underwent a critical survey about the types of the filter paper and the vacuum pumps, which are optional currently. A detailed equipment description in the method would be preferred by the participants.

INGEDE office thanks all participants for their constructive work and is every time open for any comments and input regarding all INGEDE Methods.
