Availability and quality of recovered paper is an important issue for INGEDE members.

In this context the bifa environmental institute runs a project funded by the Bavarian State Ministry of the Environment and Public Health. The project is organized in a series of workshops at which INGEDE participates. The aim is to develop an approach for optimization and solution of the issues on recovered paper. Two main risk groups were defined:

1. Quality degradation of recovered paper
2. Decreasing quantity of recovered paper

The latest workshop took place on 27 July 2011 in Munich. Based on the Kick-off workshop in February 2011 the project team had identified 10 major issues. At the actual workshop the two most important topics to work on further were identified. Which are:

Out of the first risk group: **Input of impurities and problematic material in the recovered paper**

Out of the second risk group: **Negative trade balance of recovered paper.**

We will report further in November and December when the next workshops take place.
